



YOUNG INVESTIGATOR AWARD 2013 DR. DAVID LIU, BRITISH COLUMBIA

Dr. David Liu completed his medical training at the University of Toronto and his radiology residency at the University of British Columbia. After completing his fellowship in vascular and interventional radiology at Northwestern University in Chicago, he practiced in Chicago, Portland and Spokane. During his tenure in Portland, he was named one of Portland's top physicians for two consecutive years for his exemplary patient care.

He is currently Clinical Associate Professor at the University of British Columbia's Faculty of Medicine in the Department of Radiology.

In addition to supervising numerous post-graduate students and mentoring radiology residents, his commitment to research and education is impressive. He is the founder and co-chair of the Symposium on Hepatic Oncology at Whistler (SHOW). He has co-authored impressive book chapters and over 50 peer-reviewed publications, and been invited to deliver over 70 lectures worldwide.

Dr. Liu is very active in localized cancer therapy research. He is also the youngest inducted fellow of the Society of Interventional Radiology.

His passion, enthusiasm, dedication, innovative spirit, clinical skills and kindness with colleagues and patients make him a stellar example of a model radiologist and a deserving recipient of the CAR Young Investigator Award for 2013.
