General structure	<p>Typical work day:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2-3 peripheral vascular angiography/angioplasty • 1 interventional oncology case • 1-2 biopsy or ablation • 1-2 drainage

How procedure focused is the fellowship?	Heavy focus, (around 35-40 procedures/week)
Which procedures are you responsible for?	<p>Main procedures:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Peripheral vascular angiography – 2-3/day • Transthoracic needle biopsy – 1/day • Portacath installation – 2/week • Nephrostomy – 4-5/week • Biopsies (renal, hepatic,...) – 2-3/week • Drainage (biliary, paracentesis, ...) – 2-3/week • Inferior vena cava filter placement – 1-2/week • Transcatheter arterial embolization for traumatic vascular injuries – Varies • EVAR – 3-4/month • Thrasarterial chemoembolization – 2/month • Tumor ablation – 4/month • Transjugular Intrahepatic Portosystemic Shunt (TIPS) – 1 / month
