### WORKFLOW

<b>General structure</b>	<p>One-year-fellowship: either combined breast and abdominal imaging, or full year of breast imaging or full year of abdominal imaging, depending on position and funding availability and candidate's preference.</p> <p>Flexibility due to small number of fellows.</p> <p>Monday to Friday 8:00 am to 5:00 pm</p>
<b>Are there times when fellows overlap and share work?</b>	No
<b>How many rounds are you expected to attend? Contribute to?</b>	<p>Attend: Tumor board every Friday morning (breast) and every Thursday morning (abdominal – GI), Ground rounds every Wednesday noon</p>

	Contribute: preparing and presenting at rounds, resident teaching rounds
<b>Other than rounds, are there teaching responsibilities?</b>	Yes, fellows are expected to help supervise and teach residents and/or medical students who are on the same rotation.
<b>How procedure focused is the fellowship?</b>	Heavy focus for breast rotation (average 20 procedures per week performed by a fellow, 1-3 MRI guided biopsies a week). Limited focus when on cross-sectional rotation.
<b>Which procedures are you responsible for?</b>	Stereotactic, ultrasound and MRI guided core and vacuum-assisted biopsies, preoperative wire and radioactive seed localizations, fine needle aspirations.
