### WORKFLOW

<b>General structure</b>	<p>4 clinical days and 1 research day per week.</p> <p>Daily activities include mammography, tomosynthesis, ultrasound, biopsies, wire and radioactive seed localisations, MRI.</p> <p>Radiology-pathology correlation meetings and multidisciplinary meetings 4-6 times per month.</p>
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<b>Are there times when fellows overlap and share work?</b>	No, as there is only one fellow at a time. Work is shared with 2-3 residents each period but there is enough work for everyone.
<b>How many rounds are you expected to attend? Contribute to?</b>	Radiology-pathology correlation meetings and multidisciplinary meetings 4-6 times per month.
<b>Other than rounds, are there teaching responsibilities?</b>	Yes, the fellow will engage in case discussions with residents (about one hour, once a month). The fellow will also have opportunities to supervise and to teach the residents.
<b>How procedure focused is the fellowship?</b>	Moderately focused. There are opportunities for procedures every day.
<b>Which procedures are you responsible for?</b>	The fellow is responsible for daily US-guided, stereo-guided biopsies and preoperative localizations. Weekly MRI interventions.
<b>Additional Comments about Workflow:</b>	Lots of varied cases. Excellent overall exposure. Must be able to communicate fluently in French (as per Université de Montréal requirements).

## CALL

<b>General</b>	Frequency: Approximately 1 in 4 weekdays, a week at a time. Residents do first line calls. Hours are 5:00 pm – 8:00 am weekdays, 8:00 am – 8:00 am weekends.
<b>Responsibilities on Call:</b>	General comments: General radiology, not breast specific. Modalities covered: US, plain films. No interventions. Average number of studies completed per call shift: About 20 ultrasounds, about 100-200 plain films. Subject to change as Hospitals merged recently and call structure is still under evaluation.
