## Quinte Health is seeking a well-diversified general radiologist to join the Department of Diagnostic Imaging.

Quinte Health is seeking one well-diversified general radiologist to join the Department of Diagnostic Imaging (DI) and its team of 13 radiologists.

Core services include general radiography, ultrasound, breast imaging, CT, MRI and basic interventional radiology. Ability to perform non-vascular interventional procedures such as percutaneous abscess drainage would be an asset. Fellowship training would also be an asset.

Rotating coverage includes off-site home reporting. The primary location is the Belleville site, which lies between the beautiful Counties of Hastings and the vineyard region of Prince Edward. On-site presence is also provided at the Trenton site.

Quinte Health has 1,800 staff members and 380 medical staff who provide a wide range of high quality health care services to a region of 160,000 residents. Care is provided through four hospitals – Belleville General Hospital, North Hastings Hospital, Prince Edward County Memorial Hospital and Trenton Memorial Hospitals – and includes four emergency departments, operating rooms at three sites, inpatient services (including acute medicine, intensive care, obstetrics, pediatrics, mental health, complex continuing care, rehabilitation and surgery), a rehabilitation day hospital, children's treatment centre, ambulatory care clinics, community mental health programs, an oncology centre and a range of diagnostic services. An upgraded 1.5T MRI scanner is present at the Belleville site as well as CT scanners at both the Belleville and Trenton sites. Radiography and ultrasound are provided at all 4 sites.

All candidates must be RCPSC certified and fully licensed. Anticipated start date is flexible, but the target is July 1, 2023.

The Quinte area includes some of the most diverse and beautiful countryside in Ontario.
