Start date is flexible but the availability is open now due to two wonderful but unexpected maternity leaves. Remuneration monthly based on a fixed share of fee for service billings on a fixed revenue stream. Vacation is highly flexible.

The work generally includes:

- General body ultrasound; MSK, Breast, & Obstetrical ultrasound; some basic Vascular ultrasound;
- Image-guided MSK and basic spine procedures for pain management, under both fluoroscopy and ultrasound as applicable (training available);
- Screening and diagnostic mammography;
- General radiography (modest double-digit volumes per day);
- DEXA BMD (training available);
- While we currently do not have unmet MRI or CT reading requirements, opportunities may arise.
