Our Paediatric Radiologists work across hospitals and are an important part of the wider diagnostic Radiologist team.

The radiology departments across the district at Wellington Regional Hospital, Kenepuru Hospital and Hutt Hospital are training sites for Radiology Registrars, MITs and Sonographers.
