Job Summary:

The Medical Imaging Program of NL Health Services, Urban Zone is seeking an Interventional Radiologist with interest in vascular work starting immediately. The candidate will work closely with the IR team and the Vascular Surgical team.

The successful candidate will join a group of 40 Radiologists and Nuclear Medicine Physicians located in St. John's providing tertiary care services to the local community and province. The group practice is affiliated with Memorial University of Newfoundland School of Medicine and their Radiology Residency training program giving opportunities for research and teaching.

This radiology group offers a busy service in CT, MRI, US, fluoroscopy and general X-ray, with a full scope of vascular and nonvascular interventional procedures, including supporting a busy Cancer Clinic. The Nuclear Medicine department offers the full array of services including 2 PET CT's. Services are provided in a hybrid setting of in hospital and work from home options. In addition, this city based group provides support to rural sites and occasional travel may be required.

The successful candidate is expected to have post residency fellowship training in IR and will work providing service in both their chosen subspecialty and general Radiology. There is a call expectation as well and responsibilities are shared with the Radiology Residents with an option to perform some call duties from home.

Required Qualifications

- To be considered candidates must hold a MD.
- Certification by the Royal College Physicians and Surgeons of Canada Certification (or equivalent) in Radiology.
- Interventional Radiology fellowship required.
- Must be eligible for licensure to practice by the College of Physicians and Surgeons of NL (CPSNL).
- Satisfy credentialing requirements of Eastern Health, including a satisfactory criminal record check and vulnerable sector check.

Hours of Work: Full time and part time options, plus on-call obligation

Remuneration: Remuneration is competitive and in accordance with the Newfoundland and Labrador Medical Association Memorandum of Agreement and MCP Fee Schedule. The successful candidate will join the group practice which has a shared income and expense model.
