WORKFLOW

General structure	1 week rotations between CT, body IR, and MRI/ultrasound. If only two fellows, they rotate between a combined week of CT/MRI and body IR.
Are there times when fellows overlap and share work?	No
How many rounds are you expected to attend? Contribute to?	Approximately 6-10 per year, more if interested.
Other than rounds, are there teaching responsibilities?	Involved in resident noon rounds and academic half day.
How procedure focused is the fellowship?	Moderate/heavy. 1 week IR every 3-4 weeks plus half a day of thyroid biopsies on the CT week.

Which procedures are you responsible for?	All when confident enough but can call staff when required. CT/US guided biopsies/drainages, nephrostomies, lung biopsies, feeding tubes.
Additional Comments about Workflow:	No prostate MRI. If only two fellows, you rotate only between CT and IR.
