### WORKFLOW

<b>General structure</b>	<p>The two-year neuroradiology fellowship training program is accredited by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada (RCPSC). Upon successful completion of the program, candidates who are certified in diagnostic radiology will be eligible to write the RCPSC certification examination in neuroradiology.</p> <p>The program covers all aspects of neuroradiology using standard imaging techniques including MRI, CT, ultrasound and catheter angiography as well as advanced imaging techniques including CT and MRI perfusion, MR spectroscopy, fMRI, DTI and PET/CT.</p> <p>The hospital has 10 staff/faculty neuroradiologists with complementary skill sets in all major subspecialty areas (brain imaging, spine imaging and interventions, head and neck imaging, and interventional neuroradiology). The neuroradiologists also have cross appointments with the Department of Clinical Neurosciences. As well, the Neurology Fellowship program director has a cross appointment to the Department of Surgery (Division of Otolaryngology—Head and Neck Surgery).</p>
<b>Are there times when fellows overlap and share work?</b>	No, each fellow is on a different rotation

<b>How many rounds are you expected to attend? Contribute to?</b>	Attend: Neuroscience rounds, ENT rounds Contribute to: 2 grand rounds per year  The Department of Radiology has a strong history of collaboration with other clinical departments at the university including the Department of Clinical Neurosciences, which is internationally recognized and is considered one of the top neuroscience programs in Canada. Neuroradiology fellows are invited to participate in numerous interdisciplinary rounds including neuro-oncology rounds, neuropathology rounds, stroke rounds, neurovascular rounds, neonatal neuroradiology rounds, epilepsy rounds, head and neck oncology rounds, and neurosciences grand rounds.
<b>Other than rounds, are there teaching responsibilities?</b>	Yes, teaching at the view box is supplemented by faculty lectures, a weekly academic half-day and periodic lectures from visiting professors. Fellows have four weeks of elective time in their first year. The second year provides much more elective time for fellows to focus on their interests. Established elective rotations in research, spine interventions, and interventional neuroradiology are available. Elective rotations in other areas of interest to the fellow are also encouraged.
