<b>General structure</b>	<p>The fellowship program offers a well-rounded exposure to pediatric diagnostic imaging with state-of-the-art facilities based at the Alberta Children's Hospital. The pediatric medical imaging division is an integral part of the Department of Radiology of University of Calgary. The faculty members are all pediatric fellowship trained. We perform state-of-the-art pediatric imaging including all imaging modalities. The fellowship program has a rich lecture and conference schedule. Each fellow has opportunities to teach and research.</p> <p>The Alberta Children's Hospital, an affiliate of the University of Calgary, is a 141-bed tertiary pediatric center that provides comprehensive, multi-disciplinary care to children in Southern Alberta, Southeastern British Columbia and Southwestern Saskatchewan, a catchment area of approximately 2.5 million people.</p>
