### WORKFLOW

<b>General structure</b>	<p>Responsibilities include screening and interviewing patients prior to scan, reviewing cases scheduled for next day, monitoring studies, organizing cases for readout, and contributing to teaching file</p> <p>Must be present in the scan room during this time to supervise studies</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Monday</li> <li>• Tuesday</li> <li>• Wednesday AM</li> <li>• Friday</li> </ul>
<b>Are there times when fellows overlap and share work?</b>	N/A

<b>How many rounds are you expected to attend? Contribute to?</b>	Attend and contribute to: Abdominal rounds on Tuesday mornings and the interesting MR cases and correlative studies (CT / US)
<b>Other than rounds, are there teaching responsibilities?</b>	Yes, the fellows will work alongside residents and students on rotation and will be responsible for teaching junior trainees
<b>How procedure focused is the fellowship?</b>	Moderate to heavy depending on the fellow's interest
<b>Which procedures are you responsible for?</b>	Because of the discontinuous schedule due to MR body slots being spread throughout the week, MR fellows will be asked to cover cross- sectional abdominal imaging and nonvascular intervention.
<b>Additional Comments about Workflow:</b>	Minimum 7 cases per day

## RESEARCH

<b>What are the Research Expectations?</b>	Fellows are encouraged to undertake at least one research project during their year of fellowship
<b>How much protected time is given for research (per week)?</b>	Fellows actively involved in research may be given 0.5 to 1 day of protected academic time during the week.

## CALL

<b>General</b>	Home call, except for procedures (at least 3 per weekend [1-2 per site per day is the average])
<b>Responsibilities on Call:</b>	Fellows are a resource person for the residents on-call. Their expertise may be requested for ultrasound, CT cases or interventional procedures.
