### WORKFLOW

<b>General structure</b>	The main focus of the fellowship training will be the interpretation and reporting of emergency patient CT, US and plain radiographs.
<b>Are there times when fellows overlap and share work?</b>	N/A
<b>How many rounds are you expected to attend? Contribute to?</b>	Attend and contribute to: The fellow is responsible for organizing resident teaching rounds once per week, as well as presenting cases at specific multidisciplinary rounds at the discretion of the attending staff.
<b>Other than rounds, are there teaching responsibilities?</b>	Fellows will work alongside residents and students on rotation and will be responsible for teaching of junior trainees

<b>How procedure focused is the fellowship?</b>	Little/no focus
<b>Which procedures are you responsible for?</b>	<p>The fellow is responsible for the organization and protocoling of CT studies on a daily basis, usually performed first thing in the morning and throughout the day.</p> <p>Fellows may also be asked to assess patient reactions to iodine/medications administered in the CT suite.</p> <p>The academic year is subdivided into 13 blocks of 4 weeks each. The fellow will spend 10 blocks at the JGH. Three blocks will be offered as selective, chosen from Neuroradiology, Musculoskeletal Radiology and Chest radiology (at MUHC sites).</p>
<b>Additional Comments about Workflow:</b>	Expected daily case volume: CTs 20-30, X-ray 40-50
<b>RESEARCH</b>	
<b>What are the Research Expectations?</b>	<p>The fellow is encouraged to participate in a scholarly project.</p> <p>Every effort shall be made to have their original work published in a peer-reviewed journal.</p>
<b>How much protected time is given for research (per week)?</b>	Academic time may be granted (half-day to full day per week depending on requirements of project, at the discretion of fellowship supervisor).
<b>CALL</b>	
<b>General</b>	<p>Frequency: on call 1 week in 4</p> <p>Home call, however at the discretion of the Fellowship supervisor, the fellow may be asked to participate in "in-house" call on occasion.</p> <p>On weekends and statutory holidays the fellow will come to the hospital to dictate emergency studies performed on-call (CTs +/- plain films)</p>
<b>Responsibilities on Call:</b>	Call sites include the JGH, MGH and RVH, depending on rotation.
