WORKFLOW

General structure	<p>4 clinical days and 1 research day per week.</p> <p>Daily activities include mammography, ultrasound, biopsies, wire localisations, MRI.</p> <p>Radiology-pathology correlation meetings and multidisciplinary meetings 2-4 times per month.</p> <p>Screening days at the clinic about 2-4 times per month.</p>
Are there times when fellows overlap and share work?	No, as there is only one fellow at a time. Work is shared with 2-3 residents each period but there is enough work for everyone.
How many rounds are you expected to attend? Contribute to?	Attend: Radiology-pathology correlation meetings and multidisciplinary meetings 2-4 times per month.

Other than rounds, are there teaching responsibilities?	Yes, the fellow will engage in case discussions with residents (about one hour, once a month).
How procedure focused is the fellowship?	Moderate focus.
Which procedures are you responsible for?	The fellow is responsible for daily US-guided, stereo-guided biopsies and preoperative localizations. Weekly MRI interventions.
Additional Comments about Workflow:	Lots of varied cases. Excellent overall exposure. Must be able to communicate in French.

How much protected time is given for research (per week)?	One day per week

CALL

General	Frequency: Approximately 1 in 6 weekdays, a week at a time. Residents do first line calls. Hours are 5:00 pm – 8:00 am weekdays, 8:00 am – 8:00 am weekends. On call from home.
Responsibilities on Call:	General comments: General radiology, not breast specific. Modalities covered: US, CT, plain films. No interventions. Average number of studies completed per call shift: About 10-20 ultrasounds, about 10-20 CTs. Still undetermined—Hospitals are merging in the next year and call structure will be modified to a new format
