General structure	Fellowship consists of alternating 2-month blocks at the General and Civic. Each day contains a mixture of inpatient and outpatient interventional procedures. There is more angioplasty at the Civic since that is the bigger Vascular centre, and more oncology-related procedures at the General.	
Are there times when fellows overlap and share work?	No, there is one fellow at each site.	
How many rounds are you expected to attend? Contribute to?	Attend: Dialysis rounds weekly, hepatobiliary rounds.  Contribute to: Occasionally leading IR rounds for radiology residents - once per 2-3 months.	

Other than rounds, are there teaching responsibilities?	Teaching radiology residents rotating through IR, since the fellows end up leading the majority of procedures.
How procedure focused is the fellowship?	Heavy focus.
Which procedures are you responsible for?	Fellows are responsible for percutaneous nephrostomy, biliary drainage, transjugular intrahepatic portosystemic shunting and abdominal abscess drainage. Various solid organ biopsies, percutaneous ethanol treatment of liver tumors, percutaneous gastrostomy, esophageal stenting.
	Balloon angioplasty with/without stenting. Thombolytic therapy.
