General structure	<p>Time is split between the ER reporting rooms at the General and Civic; the Civic is the trauma centre and the General has an adjacent cancer centre which tends to get more oncology cases (both new and coming in with complications).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Monday: ER - Civic Tuesday: ER - Civic Wednesday: ER - General Thursday: ER - General Friday: Academic day
Are there times when fellows overlap and share work?	No, the fellow works in conjunction with ER radiology staff to complete all studies coming through ER during the day.

General	<p>Frequency: 1/week overnight availability to be called by resident if questions about an overnight body case.</p> <p>1 weekend per 1.5 months.</p> <p>Weekend call: in house 11:00 am-4:00 pm</p>
Responsibilities on Call:	<p>General comments: Weekend call is for covering inpatient CTs that get done during the weekend, coverage by same person for both Civic and General; inpatient cases get prelied by the resident on call if asked, but the fellow is responsible for doing full dictations.</p> <p>Modalities covered: CT.</p> <p>Average number of studies completed per call shift: 10-15 body/chest CTs for inpatients, each day (Sat and Sun).</p>
Is there a call stipend?	No
Additional comments about call	Number of cases is quite variable, but cases are often very complex ICU patients for whom imaging is urgent over the weekend.
