### WORKFLOW

<b>General structure</b>	Time is spent between the Civic and General campus, with majority of rotations at Civic. One month long blocks in different modalities/neuro areas, such as spine, general MRI, head and neck, neuro angio, etc.  Neuro Spine for one month straight; neuro ENT for one month straight, etc.
<b>Are there times when fellows overlap and share work?</b>	No, each fellow is on a different rotation.
<b>How many rounds are you expected to attend? Contribute to?</b>	Attend: Neuroscience rounds, ENT rounds.  Contribute to: Interesting case rounds weekly; leading radiology resident teaching rounds (cases) 1hr long, approximately once a month

<b>Which procedures are you responsible for?</b>	Fellows are responsible for lumbar punctures, myelograms, neuroangiography, aneurysm treatment.

<b>What are the Research Expectations?</b>	Fellows are expected to complete 1 IRB-approved project during course of program with presentation at annual research day.

<b>General</b>	Frequency: 1-2 weekdays per week, 1 weekend per month. Weekday home call; weekends must come in approx. 9:00 am-4:00 pm to report
<b>Responsibilities on Call:</b>	General comments: During weeknight and weekend evening call, fellows must be available from home in case residents have questions regarding cases. Must review all stroke codes. On weekend days, must report mostly CT and some MR from ER/inpatients for both Civic/General with assistance from on-call staff. Modalities covered: CT and MR Average number of studies completed per call shift: On weekends, reporting 30+ CT head/neck and any necessary urgent MRs each day.
