General structure	 All rotations at CHEO. Different assignments for each day, including often different assignments in morning and afternoon. Also week-long additional assignments on top of daily responsibilities for types of studies that come up less often (MR enterography, fetal MRI, nuclear medicine, interventional, etc.) Monday: GI/GU AM, Ultrasound PM Tuesday: Neuro MRI Wednesday: Academic day Thursday: Neonate/ICU x-rays, portable US, outpatient x-rays Friday: CT
