### WORKFLOW

<b>General structure</b>	<p>All rotations at CHEO. Different assignments for each day, including often different assignments in morning and afternoon. Also week-long additional assignments on top of daily responsibilities for types of studies that come up less often (MR enterography, fetal MRI, nuclear medicine, interventional, etc.)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Monday: GI/GU AM, Ultrasound PM</li> <li>Tuesday: Neuro MRI</li> <li>Wednesday: Academic day</li> <li>Thursday: Neonate/ICU x-rays, portable US, outpatient x-rays</li> <li>Friday: CT</li> </ul>
<b>Are there times when fellows overlap and share work?</b>	No, as everyone gets different assignments for each day.
<b>How many rounds are you expected to</b>	Attend: Peds grand rounds (optional).

<b>attend? Contribute to?</b>	Contribute to: Interesting case rounds weekly; surgery, neurology, ortho rounds run in conjunction with radiology.

<b>How procedure focused is the fellowship?</b>	Moderate focus
<b>Which procedures are you responsible for?</b>	Access to some arthrograms, biopsies. Excellent teaching around fluoro studies (upper GI, barium enemas, etc.)

<b>General</b>	Frequency: Average of 1 weekday per week, 8-9 full weekends per year. Home call - must be available to come in to see US or CT studies in person.
<b>Responsibilities on Call:</b>	General comments: Responsible for managing calls from ER and inpatient services. Must come in 8-4 on weekends to report all inpatient/ER plain films, any CTs that come up, US done during the day, etc.  Modalities covered: XR, US, CT, MR if done  Average number of studies completed per call shift: On a weekend day: 60+ plain films, 5-10 US, variable number of CTs
