### WORKFLOW

<b>General structure</b>	Sunnybrook HSC is the largest and busiest trauma center in Canada. Here you will see the gamut of emergency presentations in all organ and body systems as well as oncologic emergencies. Traumatic presentations are equally varied with MVA multi-traumas and victims of violence providing the bulk of trauma activations. At the end of your fellowship you will be no stranger to penetrating (knives) and ballistic trauma. At Sunnybrook we have a close relationship with the emergency room physicians and the trauma surgeons and enjoy constructive feedback and patient follow-up. We also have an active stroke service and interventional cardiology team.
<b>Are there times when fellows overlap and share work?</b>	Yes. At handover, to ensure continuity of service.
<b>How many rounds are you expected to attend? Contribute to?</b>	Attend: Any rounds that you feel will be of benefit. We recommend trauma rounds and occasionally critical care rounds. Contribute to: Resident teaching rounds at least twice/year
<b>Other than rounds, are there teaching responsibilities?</b>	Educate clinicians regarding the imaging presentations of their patients at time of interpretation. Resident review.
