### WORKFLOW

<b>General structure</b>	Monday to Friday 8:00 am to 5:00 pm Rotating between UH, VH and SJ
<b>Are there times when fellows overlap and share work?</b>	Usually not, if there is an expected overlap, academic days will be scheduled to avoid.
<b>How many rounds are you expected to</b>	Attend: 2 per month Contribute to: 2 per month

<b>Other than rounds, are there teaching responsibilities?</b>	Yes, fellows will engage in resident teaching during rotations depending on how many residents are on rotation.
<b>How procedure focused is the fellowship?</b>	Heavy focus

<b>Additional Comments about Workflow:</b>	Fellows will also participate in outpatient IR clinic and management of inpatients admitted to the interventional radiology service.

<b>How much protected time is given for research (per week)?</b>	Variable depending on the number of fellows. If there are 2 fellows, then one half day per week. If there are three fellows, then one day per week.

<b>General</b>	Frequency: One in four weekdays. One week + weekend at a time Home call.
<b>Responsibilities on Call:</b>	Call is usually one week at a time, including weekend Modalities covered: All IR procedures
<b>Is there a call stipend?</b>	Yes, based on PARO rules
<b>Additional comments about call</b>	Usually on weekend call there are 3 to 8 procedures over the 2 day weekend. Weeknights are variable.
